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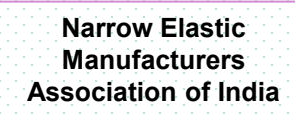
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## About CITI GLOBAL TEXTILES CONCLAVE 2023

## Government's Policy Support & Incentives

It will create 60-70 global players and will attract fresh investment of ~ USD 2.5 Bn approximately that will lead to generation of about 7.5 lakh new employment opportunities.
- **PM-MITRA** which is aimed towards setting up of 7 PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of USD 570 Mn for a period of five years.
- **SCHEME FOR CAPACITY BUILDING IN TEXTILE SECTOR (SAMARTH)** to address the skilled manpower requirement across textile sector which was formulated, under the broad policy guidelines of "Skill India" initiative and in alignment with the framework adopted for skilling programme by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.
- **NATIONAL TECHNICAL TEXTILES MISSION** with a total outlay of USD 190 Mn for promoting manufacturing of technical textiles in the country.

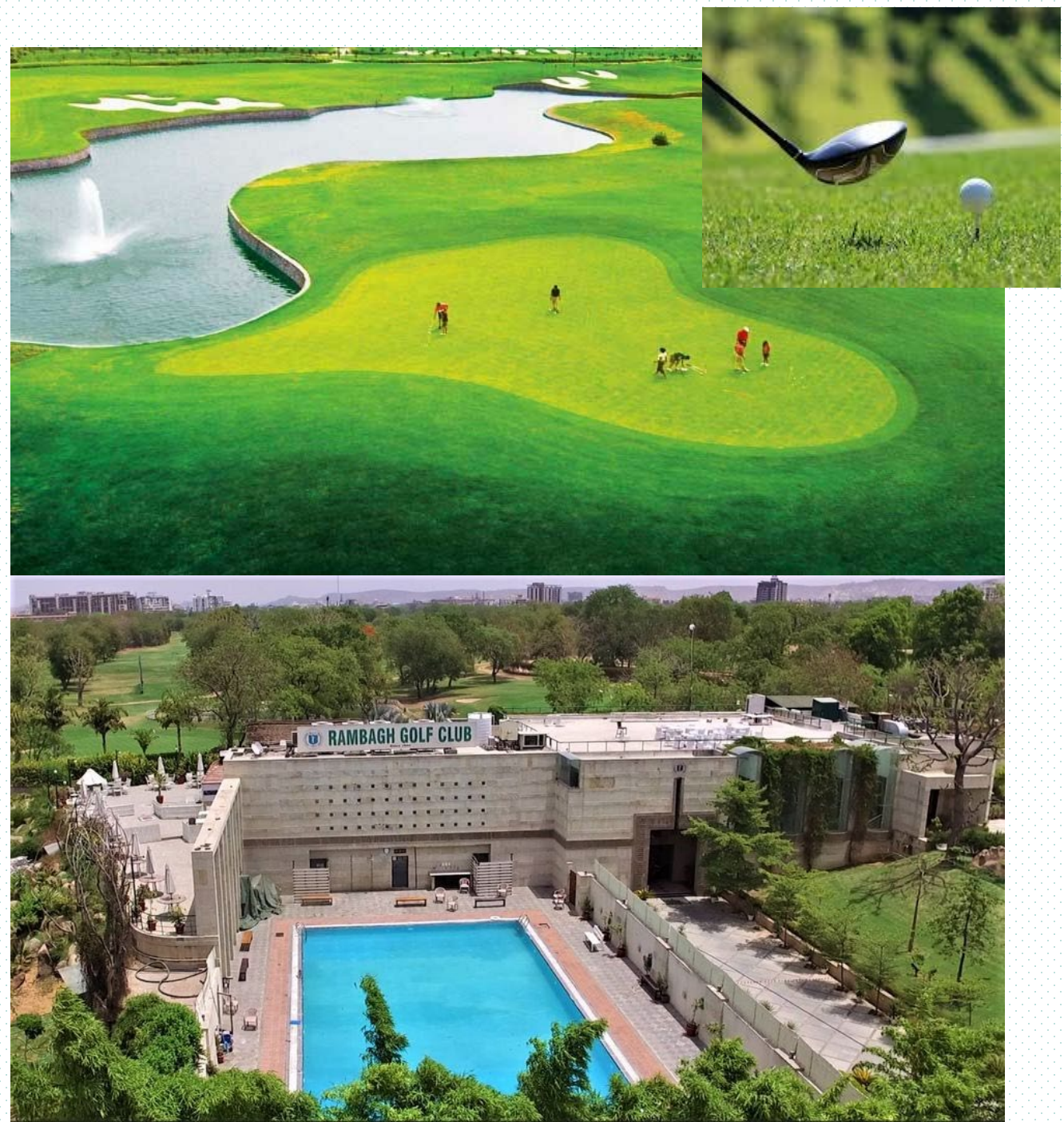


# GOLFING AT RAMBAGH GOLF CLUB
